


stripes, or drums holding more than 10 rounds of ammunition," reported Anthony Martin at examiner.com.

Christians are to love life; we are to protect it by all means possible. Whether an unborn baby in the womb, a neighbor being attacked by a burglar, or an elderly person in their latter years, all life is precious in the sight of God.

When we as a people get to the point that we are unwilling to defend life, eventually we will get to the point that we are unwilling to defend ourselves.

Our right to bear arms was not haphazardly written into our Bill of Rights; it was just another instance of the great and learned wisdom of our Founders. Larry Pratt, Executive Director of Gun Owners of America, writes:

The wisdom of the framers of the Constitution is consistent with the lessons of the Bible. Instruments of defense should be dispersed throughout the nation, not concentrated in the hands of the central government. In a Godly country, righteousness governs each man through the Holy Spirit working within. The government has no cause to want a monopoly of force; the government that desires such a monopoly is a threat to the lives, liberty and property of its citizens. The assumption that only danger can result from people carrying guns is used to justify government monopoly of force. The notion that the people cannot be trusted to keep and bear their own arms informs us that ours, like the time of Solomon, may be one of great riches but is also a time of peril for free people. If Christ is not our King, we shall have a dictator to rule over us, just as Samuel warned.

You can rest assured that gun opponents will begin a call for the banning of all handguns and eventually all weapons. A government that desires to unarm the populace is one that intends to harm it.

For Christians, if we willfully give away are right to self-defense to the point of not defending one's own life; it is the equivalent of suicide.

TO THE STREETS

WE the People are responsible for defending our God-given liberties as admonished from history by John Quincy Adams. Here are some ways to put feet to this defense:

- 4. If you are not already a member, please consider joining the National Rifle Association (NRA) and/or Gun Owners of America (GOA). They are solid on protecting Americans' 2nd Amendment rights.
- 5. Make sure you know the 2nd Amendment position of all candidates, local, state, and federal, because all politics are local and like the recent shooting we saw in Aurora, Colorado, that municipality had stricter gun control laws than the rest of the state.

Be sure to engage gun control advocates to get them to fully explain their positions. See if they are capable of having an intelligent conversation on crime and gun ownership. Share this <u>article</u> with them and show them how crime actually goes down when gun ownership increases.
